Melbourne Picnic

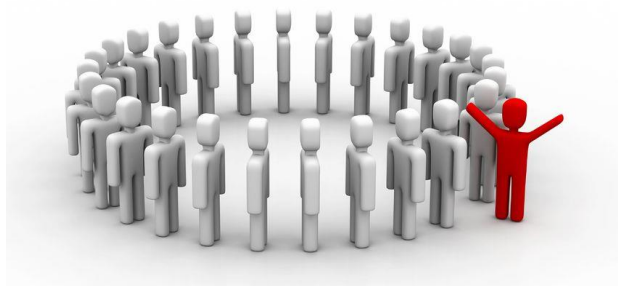
The Anzac Day Picnic is again planned for the Stringybark Area, of Jells Park, Wheelers Hill, starting at about 10.30am
