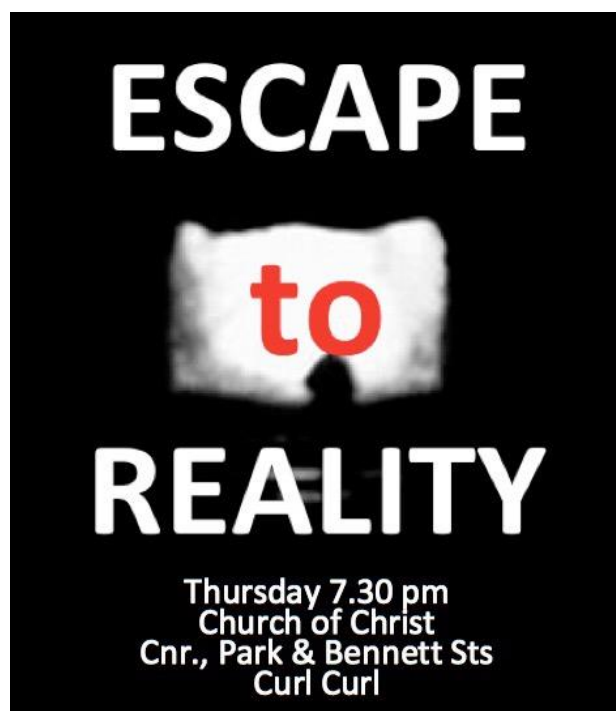
New Congregation
